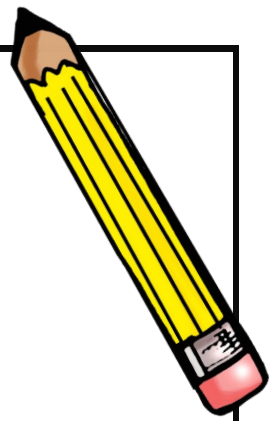

My students love to use these worksheets—it allows them to really show what they know and how they relate to the novel. I sometimes use them alone and sometimes add a few chapter questions to go along with them.

I use the longer response sheets as a “mix and match”, individually and in different combinations depending on the chapter.

Use the blank copies of the worksheets to challenge the students to come up with additional question. You can also ask students to pick questions from the list of extras I provided.

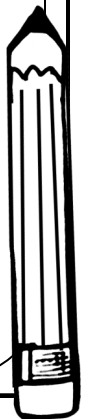

Here is a list of additional questions to use with the novel and the blank graphic organizers.

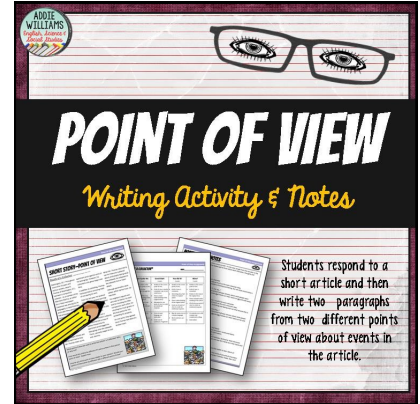
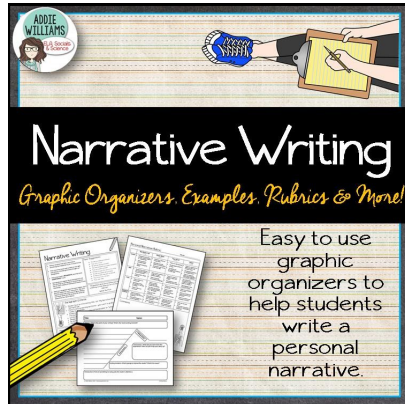
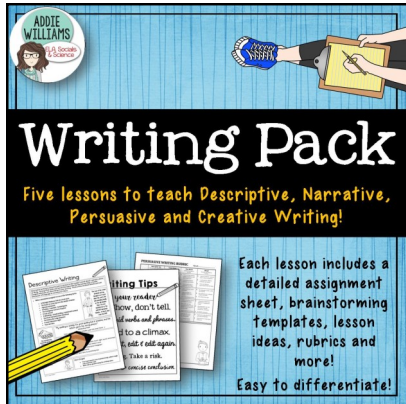
1. Would this book make a good movie? TV show? Why or why not?

22. Do you think that the main character has any regrets? What could they have done differently?



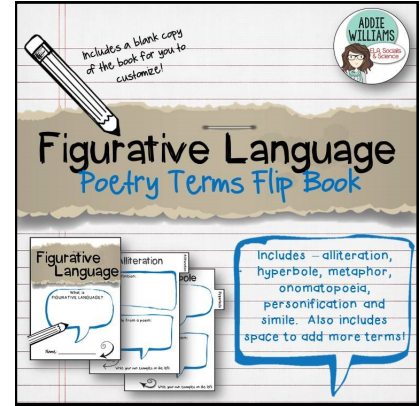
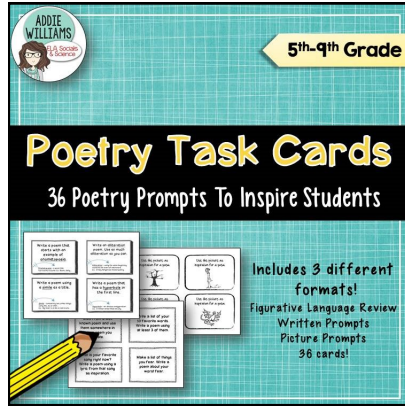

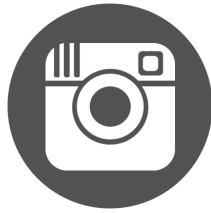
